**Laramie County Clerk Debra Lee today announced her candidacy for the Laramie County Clerk's position.**

Lee has served as county clerk since June 8, 2016, when she was appointed to fill the vacancy created due to the unfortunate passing of long-time clerk Debbye Lathrop.
