OUT OF STATE MEETINGS EXPENDITURES OF LEGISLATORS

The following apply to the information contained in this list:

1. This list contains travel and per diem payments (actual expenses) to legislators for out of state travel on official legislative business. The Legislature participates in several organizations such as the National Conference of State Legislatures (NCSL), The Energy Council, the Council of State Governments (CSG), the Western Legislative Conference, the Education Commission of the States and the State Legislative Leaders Foundation (SLLF). The presiding officers appoint legislators to committees of these organizations. Legislators may attend without prior approval a maximum of two out of state meetings per year to organizations to which the Legislature is a member or is approved by the presiding officers or Management Council subject to availability of budget. Travel in excess of the two authorized meetings requires Management Council approval.
2. Most out of state travel involves legislators who have been appointed to committees of organizations in which the Legislature participates.
3. The Management Council must approve any out of state travel to a meeting outside the continental United States (lower 48) by a vote of 2/3 of council members.
4. Legislators receive reimbursement for actual expenses associated with authorized out of state travel, subject to limitations contained in Management Council travel policies. Legislators receive no salary when engaged in authorized out of state travel.
